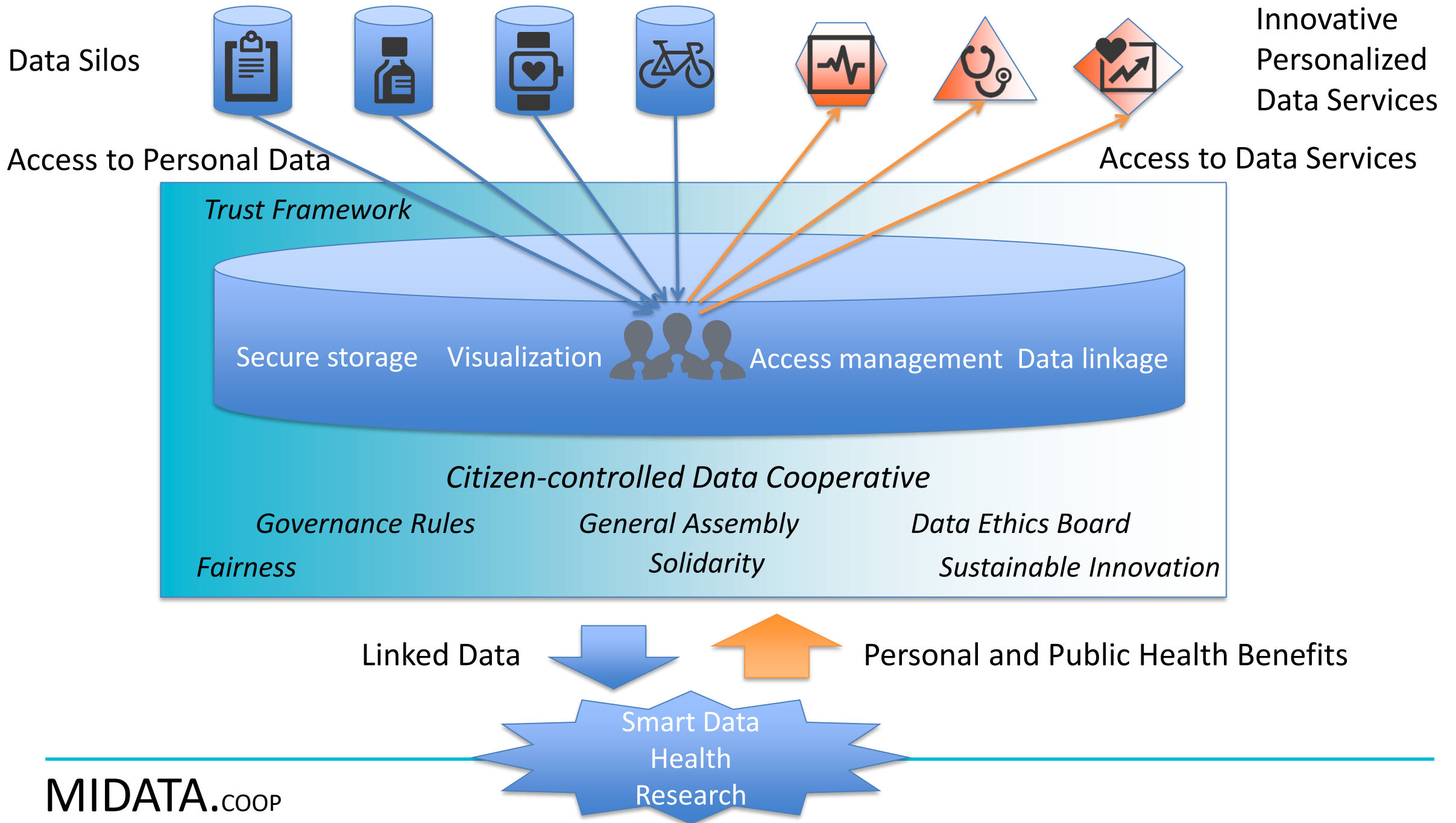


A new trust-promoting framework

- **Citizen owned**
 - Cooperatives
- **Not for profit**
 - Revenues are reinvested for the benefits of members and society
- **Open source**
 - Code available on Github
- **Transparent**
 - Transparent governance
- **Secure**
 - Data encryption, only members possess key
- **Regional**
 - Promotion of regional linked MIDATA cooperatives
