The Cancer moonshot 2.0. What is it about?



- USA President Biden re-ignited the Cancer Moonshot in May 2022 with the following 2 goals:
 - Reduce mortality from cancer by 50% in 25 years
 - Increase the quality of life for those living with and surviving Cancer
- The Global Health Catalyst engaged with the White House to extend the Cancer Moonshot globally = Cancer Moonshot 2.0

The Cancer moonshot 2.0. facilitated by the Global Health Catalyst to Africa




- December 2022: The Cancer Moonshot announces over \$300 million extending the Cancer Moonshot to Africa during the U.S. Africa leader's summit
- Dr Jill Biden met with African First Ladies many who support the elimination of cervical cancer

The Cancer moonshot 2.0. facilitated by the Global Health Catalyst to India



- June 23, 2023: White House Cancer Moonshot Announces Public and Private Sector Commitments to Reduce the Burden of Cancer in India
- Included Developing an artificial intelligence (AI)-enabled digital pathology platform that will be utilized for cancer diagnosis, prognosis, and prediction of therapeutic benefit, as well as AI-based automated radiotherapy treatment for cancers of the cervix, head, and neck.

The Cancer moonshot 2.0. facilitated by the Global Health Catalyst to India, Australia, Japan




- September 21, 2024: Quad Countries Launch Cancer Moonshot Initiative to Reduce the Burden of Cancer in the Indo-Pacific
- The Quad Cancer Moonshot will serve to strengthen the overall cancer care ecosystem in the Indo-Pacific by improving health infrastructure, expanding research collaborations, building data systems, and providing greater support for cancer prevention, detection, treatment, and care.

- October 25, 2024: Meeting at the White House towards establishing a Global Cancer Fund with Billions of Dollars per year
- Questions addressed during the White House Meeting:
 - Why is this important today?
 - Do you support this?
 - How should it be structured?
 - What partnerships should be created?
 - What can we learn from previous Global Funds like for HIV/AIDS etc?
