Review

All the four Covid-19 vaccines now registered are approximately 100% effective on severe Covid. Mass vaccination is delayed in the EU, but I expect that by summer vaccines will be available for the whole population in the EU, too.

Cancer survivors should receive priority vaccination, which should translate into 2-4 months anticipation in the EU as compared to the general population. A call for priority vaccination also to caregivers and family members should be critically considered, the key priority is for cancer survivors.
