





Figure 1A The health consequences causally linked to smoking

SHS kills 1.2 million people/ year

- 65 000 of these premature and preventable deaths are in children under 15 years
- Smoking during pregnancy is responsible for about one third of the additional stillbirths and infant deaths among the most deprived households Maternal exposure to second-hand smoke during pregnancy also increases the risk of a baby being stillborn

• If we really are to prevent cancer we will prevent infant deaths

WHO FCTC 5.3: Fire wall

Article 5.3 of the WHO Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (180 countries signed)

Parties shall act to protect policies from commercial and other interests of the tobacco industry Legally binding

WHO FCTC 5.3 : no fire wall, at all

2015, Youth Smoking Prevention brought a case against the **State of the Netherlands** in order to end the structural, influence of the tobacco lobby on the government's anti-smoking policy.

The request: enforcement of article 5.3 of the WHO FCTC

WHO FCTC 5.3 : cordon sanitaire



Addiction: brain disease


- 2/3 children smoking one first cigarette become daily smokers
- 95 % smoking cessation fail
- The powerful addictive substance in tobacco, is nicotine. Nicotine dependence is included in the International Classification of Diseases (ICD-10).
- Nicotine dependence is also included in the <u>DSM-V</u> (range heroin and cocaine.

> 70 substances in tobacco smoke are carcinogenic. Deadly and addictive by design

- Cigarettes are for 30 % composed out of added substances
- Sugar makes the taste more attractive & one of the combustion products of sugar (acetaldehyde) enhances the addictive effect of nicotine
- Added ammonia-based chemicals elevate nicotine uptake in the brain



Rigged cigarettes: filter fraud ventilation

2019 Emission levels forgery – EU Falsification of documents / deception (ventilation holes)



Tobacco manufacturers declared **emission levels** of tar, nicotine and carbon monoxide (TNCO) of their tobacco products which were lower than the **actual emission** levels when the tobacco products **are used as intended**, to which **end the tobacco manufacturers have deliberately misled the compulsory laboratory tests**







DIESEL EMISSIONS SCANDAL: FORMER VOLKSWAGEN CEO STANDS TRIAL IN GERMANY

Tobacco Products Directive- TPD – EU law

- Lawsuit rigged cigarettes against the Dutch Government through the District court of Rotterdam
- Referred the case to the European Court of Justice with a number of preliminary questions





European Union's Court of Justice 2-2022

- Allows Dutch administrative court to review the way that filtered cigarettes emissions are measured
- In 2018 the National Institute for Public Health and the Environment (RIVM) found that TNCO emissions were 2-26 times higher than the legally permitted standards of 10 mgr tar , 1 mgr nicotine and 10 mgr carbon monoxide during real life consumption

2-9-2022 District Court Rotterdam

The Dutch Administrative court must base its assessment of our enforcement request on a measurement that comes closest to the actual poison intake of smokers

End of filter?

- Increase taxes every year > 10 % (also part of EU cancer prevention plan)
- Minimum price essential
- Decrease Points of Sale (POS) by license system

There are more than a 1.1 billion <u>smokers</u> in the world, and it's estimated that 8 million people die every year as a result of their addiction to cigarettes. By any reasonable metric, smoking is perhaps the greatest and most salient public health emergency of our time. The scale of this crisis is magnified even more by the pervasive influence of tobacco companies, which have stopped at nothing to derail regulations, confuse policymakers and obscure the plight of their products.

Which is why only through continuous efforts spearheaded by the World Health Organisation have major breakthroughs in the fight against smoking been achieved. Ever since the entry into force of the <u>Framework Convention on Tobacco</u> <u>Control</u> (FCTC) in 2005 and its first <u>Protocol to Eliminate</u> <u>Illicit Trade in Tobacco Products</u> in September of 2018, the fight against Big Tobacco's influence and underhand tactics


Cigarette taxes helped save hundreds of thousands of kids' lives every year

For the study, the researchers examined the link between cigarette taxes and infant mortality in 159 high, medium and low income countries using data from 2008 to 2018.

Cigarette taxation and neonatal and infant mortality: A longitudinal analysis of 159 countries Raising taxes on tobacco was associated with a reduction in neonatal and infant mortality globally.

Implementing recommended levels of taxation in LMICs should be a priority since this is where the lowest levels of taxation and the largest potential infant mortality benefits exist.





What more can we do-

- Mass claim with new legislation with ongoing fraud, buying influencers, fraudulous filter ventilation, lobbying and marketing
- End game policy (Australia, New Zealand, Denmark, Singapore, Malaysia) children born after 2016 will never be allowed to buy cigarettes. (they will be 18 in 2035, today they are 5 years old)

Tobacco use is the leading cause of preventable death in the world. A human rights approach to ending tobacco is unique because it implores or requires governments to protect their citizens by implementing tobacco control laws and strategies to end the tobacco epidemic based on legally-binding human rights norms.

A human rights approach

Smoking negatively impacts the right to life, right to health, right to education, children's rights, women's rights, and many others. For example, the tobacco industry often targets their marketing to specific populations based on gender, race, sexual identity and age. Some of these groups smoke at much higher rates than the general population, and they
